The National Strategic Research Institute (NSRI) at the University of Nebraska is the only University Affiliated Research Center (UARC) in the country dedicated to delivering solutions for Combating Weapons of Mass Destruction (CWMD) to U.S. Strategic Command (USSTRATCOM) and across other federal agencies. NSRI provides essential engineering, research, and development capabilities across the CWMD missions. As one of 13 DoD established UARC's, NSRI operates in the public interest and in a special strategic long term partnership with our DoD sponsor.
